Series Description

The Artifact Guardians is an adventure trilogy in which archaeologist Leila Sterling doesn't just dig up artifacts, she catches artifact thieves. When she uncovers the secrets of her own past and evokes the wrath of the illegal artifact dealer Faris Al-Rashid, her life becomes entangled in a web of thievery, love, and betrayal.

In Book 1, The Stolen Papyrus, Leila is forced to work with the man who last saw her father alive. She discovers clues to the events leading up to her father's death that seem to all point to a mysterious papyrus that reveals the location of a queen's tomb.

In Book 2, The Lost Sepulcher, Leila wakes up in the middle of the desert, alone. As she tries to find her way home, whispers of a lost tomb draw her deeper into the desert and into a world of ancient secrets and societies.

In Book 3, The Aegean Vault, a bomb goes off in Cairo and there's a threat for another, unless Leila can rescue her mother from Al-Rashid and stop him from destroying everything she loves.
